



## SIGN THE LETTER TO THE BOARD!

After Friday's court victory declaring Qantas's outsourcing of ground work was unlawful we are pushing ahead for workers to be reinstated and compensated. There are two main developments on this:

- Please sign the [letter to the Qantas board](#) demanding it backs reinstatement and compensation for workers and drops plans to appeal. We need as many signatures as we can get behind this to put the pressure on the Qantas board to hold senior management to account.
- Our legal team was back in court on Wednesday August 4th pushing for a hearing date to begin the process of reinstatement and compensation. Qantas's legal team argued that this should be put on hold while they appeal the case. The judge has asked for submissions from both sides on the way forward and has set another court date for August 18.

We will soon start gathering information to present in court about the circumstances of Qantas workers so the judge can determine the next step. The best way for you to have your interests represented and make sure your voice is heard in this process is by **joining the Union**.

We are talking to politicians and other supporters on how to press the case to get Qantas workers the outcome they deserve. We got this far in holding Qantas to account because workers stayed united and focused.
