While members have voted in their thousands over the last week, **Toll have been forced to withdraw B rates for new employees from the bargaining table.** This is a big win, and congratulations to each and every one of you.

The fight is still on to address the serious outstanding issues around:

- 1.** Site rates and safeguards for use of outside hire
- 2.** Full utilisation
- 3.** A decent pay rise
- 4.** Finalising Local Agreements
- 5.** Signing the deed to protect your conditions through the sale process

Until these issues are addressed, the job security of every Toll worker is on the line. Together we've made sure B rates are off the table. **We MUST use our collective power to fix these other issues.**

NEXT STEPS

The delegate-led bargaining committee will be meeting with Toll again on Monday. Delegates will also be meeting to talk through what protected action can look like if Toll don't step up and resolve these urgent issues. The message from the ballot was clear: Toll TWU members will fight for what is fair.
