The TWU will be meeting again with FedEx on **29th September** to demand they move to implement the following outstanding issues:

- ✗ Commitments to stop FedEx **outsourcing your work**
- ✗ A **fair wage offer** for 2021 and 2022, as well as a payment for 2020
- ✗ Improved **consultation** on workplace change
- ✗ A fair **superannuation** offer

The offer on the table to attack job security and your good conditions is not good enough. You have made FedEx Australia's top-performing transport company, delivering record revenue and profit, and risked your health and safety throughout the pandemic.

Until these issues are addressed, the job security of every FedEx worker is on the line. You've shown that you demand the same commitment from the company that you've given them in making them Australia's number 1 in transport.

TWU members have voted and it is now up to FedEx to respond, come back to the bargaining table and do what is right.
