



## 24-HOUR STRIKE ENDORSED

Your delegates have now collectively endorsed a 24-hour Australia-wide BevChain strike.

Last week we updated you that strike action may be necessary if BevChain didn't come to the table on our remaining claims. Your bargaining committee has already won significant improvements to the agreement after your strong Protected Action Ballot result, including commitment to a national agreement, stronger disputes and consultation provisions, driver indemnity insurance, more union meetings and other key wins. But we need one final push on the company to resolve the outstanding issues.

Delegates at major transport companies have all endorsed 24-hour strikes if outstanding issues were not agreed to this week. If necessary we are preparing for an industry stoppage.

- ✗ **Job security** - including outside hire ratio, full utilisation and labour hire conversion
- ✗ Pathway to **15% super**
- ✗ Fair and reasonable **pay and allowance increases**

Now is the most critical time in our fight. You've made it clear you're willing to fight for your job security. Unless BevChain comes to the table now with an offer that safeguards your good, secure jobs, strike action is on the cards. **Let's keep standing together and secure the best possible agreement.**
