



ROLLING STOPPAGES RESCHEDULED FOR TUESDAY 23 NOVEMBER

This week TWU members across Australia overwhelmingly endorsed a modified claim with the same average annual costs as the proposal put by the company.

That claim would put money in your pockets sooner, but FedEx wants to keep your money and slow pay increases down.

In bargaining today the company refused to move on its claim, and has indicated it sees no further benefit in meeting. **FedEx has left us no choice but to take further action.** The rolling strikes will each be four hours across three days, with VIC/TAS actions to take place Tuesday 23 November.
