FedEx's decision to lock workers out, though, does mean that we are able to respond with action giving limited notice. **That means Queensland (as well as SA) can take action tomorrow.**

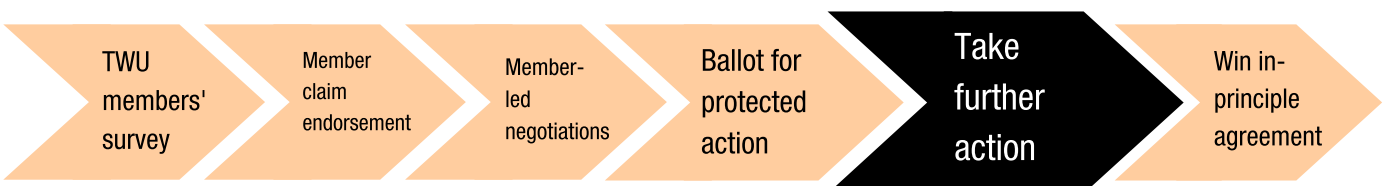
