

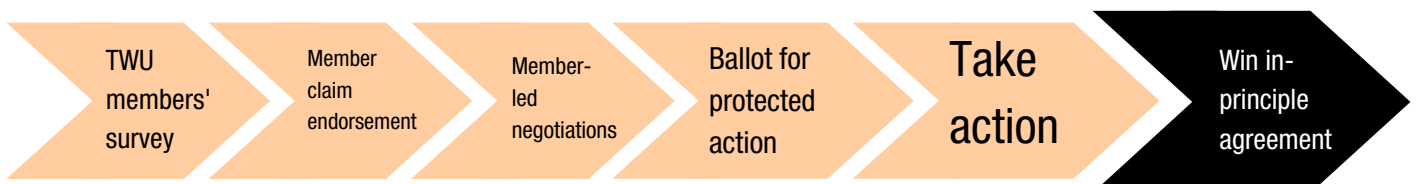


YOUR UNION-WON BACKPAY IS ON THE WAY
