TRANSPORT WORKER SURVEY: SHOCKING RESULTS REVEALED

2500 transport workers responded to our survey on close contacts and rapid antigen testing in less than a week, with several reports of:



Workers asked to return to work while still testing positive or symptomatic



Casual workers with no sick leave with no choice but to keep working



Workplaces and trucks **not cleaned** after positive cases



Workers with **positive family members** told there's no need to test



Docked pay and criticism for isolating



Management **not informing workers**of positive
workplace cases

What's unsurprising is that **96% of respondents support free RATs**, and **87% are concerned about working with a close contact**. After being on the front lines of the pandemic for two years, transport workers deserve to be safe at work, and to keep your families safe. <u>You can see the full survey results here.</u>

- We're writing to supply chain clients like Apple, Aldi and Amazon to take a stand against positive workers in their chain being asked to work, and to ensure all transport operators have covid-safe plans.
- We've secured priority access to RATs for transport workers in Victoria after a strong campaign. We're ramping up the pressure in other states, and right across the union movement, we're calling for free and accessible RATs for ALL Australians.
