

QANTAS CANCELS BARGAINING MEETING

48 hours before your member-led team was due to meet with Qantas to discuss the agreement that expired in 2020, Qantas cancelled the meeting.

This is typical of Qantas, which has shown it has no respect for workers. Your team will not stand for Qantas' corporate nonsense and will take your frustrations directly to the bargaining table. We commit to getting a new agreement in place as quickly as possible, and will do everything in our power to do so.

- A minimum of 4.6% increase
