## DNATA WAGE OFFER WOULD SEND Your pay backwards

After cancelling two bargaining meetings, Dnata has returned to the negotiation process only to present a wage offer that for many of you **would put you on the same pay as the Award.** The Award is the **bare minimum,** and your member-led team does not endorse Dnata's offer.

POSITION	WAGE OFFER	WHAT IT MEANS
1st year catering attendants and 1st year senior catering attendants	0% increase	This would put you on the Award - <b>the bare minimum</b>
2nd year catering attendants and 2nd year senior catering attendants	1.5% increase	This is <b>severely below inflation</b> and would mean your <b>wages are</b> <b>falling backwards</b> in real terms
3rd year catering attendants and 3rd year senior catering attendants	<b>3%</b> increase	3% is still <b>well below inflation</b> and would also mean your <b>wages are going backwards</b>

## WHAT HAPPENS NOW?

This wage offer from Dnata is unacceptable, and your member-led team **does not endorse** it. The TWU will be coming onsite this coming week to seek your **endorsement for protected action** to force Dnata to come back to the table with a fair offer.

If you're not a member, now is the time to join to fight for a fair deal.

Dnata must come back to the table with a fair wage offer which recognises the important work that you do.
