

## DNATA PAB BALLOT: HOW TO VOTE

On 5 August 2022 the Fair Work Commission approved an application by the TWU to hold a **Protected Action Ballot** following endorsement by your member-led negotiating team. That's because Dnata is attacking your hard-won conditions in 5 key ways:

- 1.** Job security
- 2.** A fair pay and superannuation offer
- 3.** Real consultation
- 4.** Fair conditions for part-time workers
- 5.** EA expiry in 2024 so we can fight as an industry

**Here's what you need to know:**

### ELECTION NOTICE

On **Friday August 19**, if you've provided a valid email address or mobile telephone number, you'll receive an email or text from the election company notifying you that a ballot is going to take place.



If you did not provide an email address or mobile number you will receive information in the post.

#### RECEIVING BY EMAIL OR TEXT

If you have not received your election notice by **22 August** and you are a TWU member who is eligible to vote, please **contact Vero Voting on 1300 702 898 or at the email support@verovoting.com.au as soon as possible** to provide them with your details to make sure you can participate in the ballot and have your voice heard!

#### RECEIVING BY POST

If you have not received your election notice by **22 August**, we encourage you to contact Vero Voting to ensure your name is included on the roll. Even if your post might be delayed – it is better to contact the ballot company to ensure your voice is heard.

### WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

You'll receive more information from the ballot company next week ahead of the **vote opening on Monday August 29**. This information will include your link to the online ballot and your unique password to conduct your vote.
