Dnata TWU members have **stood up** with an overwhelming support to take protected industrial action if Dnata don't come to the table to settle a fair agreement

The message to Dnata is clear. **The offer on the table is not good enough** and workers will stand together and take action for a better deal.

While members have voted massively over this week, your member-led bargaining committee will be back at bargaining table next week to take all steps to settle outstanding issues:
