Your member-led bargaining team met with Dnata's management this week to kick off negotiations for an improved EA.

Dnata agreed to TWU's demands to improve consultation, delegates rights and inductions.

KEY TWU CLAIMS

- **Superannuation** so Dnata workers can retire with enough super to be comfortable.
- **Pay** Increases to keep up with cost of living.
- Pay parity parity with classification in Alpha agreement
- Consultation so you have a real say in changes that are proposed
- Delegates' rights so members have the representation and support you deserve
- Inductions so every new worker can understand their rights and the role of the TWU
