

BARGAINING UPDATE



After months of public campaigning led by the TWU, slamming Qanta's bribery bonus - the company has **been forced to increase its offer.**

The proposal previously made to QAL workers of 2% increases in 2022 and 2023 with no backpay, will now be increased to 3% for the two years.

Your TWU negotiating team is standing strong at the bargaining table and now is when we need everyone to win the best outcome.

PAY INCREASE PROPOSAL

- ▶ 3% from September 2022
- ▶ 3% from September 2023
- ▶ Increased pool of workers who qualify for the bonus

These initial results have only been achieved because members and delegates across the country have **stood together.**
