

QANTAS HIGH COURT HEARING NEXT WEEK

Next Friday 18 November, both parties will make submissions as to whether or not Qantas should be granted leave to appeal, following two Federal Court rulings against them.

We will likely hear a decision on the day about whether Qantas will be granted leave to appeal in the High Court.



WHAT WILL HAPPEN?

- At the special leave hearing, lawyers from both sides of the case will give legal arguments as to whether or not the case should be heard in the High Court.
- Based on this hearing, the High Court will decide whether to grant Qantas special leave to appeal.
- If Qantas is **not** granted special leave to appeal, the company will have exhausted all of its appeal options, and the case will move to compensation hearings in December.
- If Qantas **is** granted special leave to appeal, we will keep up our strong fight, and mount the strongest possible case in the High Court after two emphatic Federal Court rulings that you were illegally outsourced.
- We'll update everyone as soon as we know the outcome of the hearing
