Fed Government to intervene High Court fight

Workplace Relations Minister Tony Burke has now written to the High Court and both parties to provide notice that he intends to exercise his right to intervene in the case.



- Submissions have not yet been provided outlining the reasons for the Minister's decision. Still, we hope this may reflect the important issues we have raised with the Federal Government.
- Qantas' appeal is based on the idea that workers would have needed the immediate right to take protected industrial action when they were outsourced. We have argued to the court and to the Federal Government that this would seriously undermine the protective intention of the law.
