

# NEWAY CEASES OPERATIONS

## WHAT'S HAPPENING NOW

- **Neway is no longer in operation.** You should have received a separation certificate or a statement of service and a redundancy notification
- Make sure your **classification** reflects the grade you are being paid at. Contact the administrators if there is a discrepancy
- The **second creditors' meeting** is in April – that is when it is most likely the company will go into liquidation

## YOUR ENTITLEMENTS

- Outstanding payments are likely to be paid through the government's **Fair Entitlements Guarantee (FEG)** scheme
- FEG applications cannot be made until after liquidation and can take up to 16 weeks to process

## FEG IS GENERALLY AVAILABLE WHEN:

- The employer is in **liquidation** and employment was terminated as a result
- Employees can't access entitlements through **other means**
- Employees are an **Australian citizen** or hold a **permanent residency** or **special category visa**
