NEWAY CEASES OPERATIONS

WHAT'S HAPPENING NOW

- Neway is no longer in operation. You should have received a separation certificate or a statement of service and a redundancy notification
- Make sure your classification reflects the grade you are being paid at. Contact the administrators if there is a discrepancy
- The second creditors' meeting is in April that is when it is most likely the company will go into liquidation

YOUR ENTITLEMENTS

- Outstanding payments are likely to be paid through the government's Fair Entitlements Guarantee (FEG) scheme
- FEG applications cannot be made until after liquidation and can take up to 16 weeks to process

FEG IS GENERALLY AVAILABLE WHEN:

- The employer is in liquidation and employment was terminated as a result
- Employees can't access entitlements through other means
- Employees are an Australian citizen or hold a permanent residency or special category visa
