IT'S TIME TO BARGAIN

Negotiations at Virgin are on their way and your recent participation in the survey has significantly contributed to build our claim in the upcoming bargaining meetings.



Aviation workers have been building strength across companies. Recently Dnata workers stood together to win a 17.2% pay rise in two years.

Workers across the country have said in the survey that their priority is to **improve Job Security** and push for a substantial increase in pay.

KEY FINDINGS

- 74% want more full-time positions available.
- **95.5%** want an increase in Superannuation
- 80% want an increase in Part time hours
- 98.73% want improved higher duties
- 93% agree that VA should insource work at Perth, Sunshine Coast and Gold Coast.

TWU members have made it clear that this agreement needs to considerably lift wages and conditions. We will be serving a strong claim that reflects your concerns because Virgin workers deserve more than what they are getting.

NEGOTIATIONS UNDERWAY



- Delegates will be meeting to discuss the final claim that will then be brought onsite for endorsement by the membership.
- An initial meeting was held on 24 May to commence negotiations and set out a bargaining schedule - the first bargaining meeting will be held in the week commencing 19 June 2023.
