Menzies have heard you and they are **committed to fix the quality and supply issues with your uniforms.**

MENZIES ATTACK ON CLAIMS

The log of claims that Menzies presented is a clear attack on your entitlements.

Menzies showed that they want to remove your entitlements that have been won over the years, and that they would rather workers be on the award.

Menzies claims were an attack on:

- ✗ Superannuation
- ✗ Overtime triggers
- ✗ The ability to earn allowances
- ✗ Penalty rates
- ✗ Casual conversion
- ✗ Delegates rights and leave
