HUGE YES RESULT ON PROTECTED ACTION




TWU members at Surveillance Australia Pty Ltd have **stood up** with overwhelming support to pursue protected industrial action if SAPL don't come to the table with a fair deal.

By standing together, TWU members have sent a resounding message to the company that the offer **must improve** and that if it doesn't, **members are willing to take action to ensure it does.**

MAIN POINTS:







We have had 2 FWC conciliation conferences with SAPL. Because of your collective pressure, we are moving closer to a deal since the PABO.

We have pressed SAPL to focus on the remuneration package instead of their lifestyle-based offer.

WHAT HAPPENS NOW:

- The PAB result means TWU members have obtained rights under the Fair Work Act to take protected industrial action, pending a five-day notification period to Surveillance Australia.
- So far, no decision has been made to trigger any of the actions now available.
- A FWC conciliation conference is scheduled for Tuesday 14 May, which we hope will move closer to a resolution on the EA package.
