# MENZIES PRESENTS LOG OF CLAIMS

In this week's negotiating meeting your member-led bargaining team went through Menzies' log of claims and have made it clear in our meeting that workers will not go backward in the establishment of national EA.

Though we've had some important wins it's crucial we keep the pressure up with Menzies presenting attacks to your current conditions.



#### WINS

Thanks to the pressure of workers Menzies are looking to introduce parental leave across the country.

Workers to be paid at 200% for same day shift extensions for the extension portion of the shift. Your claim is for all overtime to be paid at 200%, but this is a step in the right direction.

## **MENZIES TRIED TO ATTACK YOUR CONDITIONS**

- Menzies is trying to make it harder for workers to take personal/sick leave. It wants to limit personal leave evidence for when a worker takes more than 1 days personal leave to:
  - A medical certificate issued by a doctor through face to face appointment or video Telehealth; or
  - Statutory Declaration (Max 4 Statutory Declarations per year and limit who can witness the document by banning Commonwealth stat decs)



Menzies also wants to limit the amount of delegates at each airport.

This would reduce our power in the workplace and we have rejected this proposal from Menzies.
