OCEANIA MUST LISTEN TO WORKERS



This week your member led bargaining team met with Oceania to discuss a way forward following a strong NO vote from workers.

Congratulations on your unity. We now need to keep up the pressure on Oceania to secure a fair agreement.

YOUR OUTSTANDING CLAIMS

Due to the overwhelming no vote Oceania you have sent a strong message to Oceania that they need to address these claims that are important to you including:

- Minimum guaranteed hours per week
- Paid meal break
- Shorter duration for the EA
- Pathway to full time employment
- Increased redundancy protections
- Improved rostering practices that allow for a better work life balance including 2 days off in a row and no more than 7 days to be rostered in a row
- Classification structure so workers are appropriately paid for the skills being used

We have urged the company to ensure that we finalise an EA that workers can support quickly.
