Following reports of a trading halt at Rex Airlines, the TWU is urgently contacting Rex to get clarity and commence discussions on workers being prioritised as this unfolds.

Media has reported Deloitte experts have been engaged to support Rex with this process. The TWU worked day in day out with Deloitte on the Virgin Australia administration and sale. Just as we helped revive Virgin in 2020, we're ready to work just as hard to keep Rex flying.

NEXT STEPS

- We're writing to Rex calling for an urgent meeting to discuss the impact on workers
- · Workers must remain at the centre of consultation and must be prioritised
- · We will keep members updated as more information comes to light
