

REX HAS ENTERED VOLUNTARY ADMINISTRATION



After yesterday's reports of a trading halt at Rex Airlines, EY contacted the TWU to confirm it had been appointed as administrators.

IMPACT ON WORKERS

In worker briefings this morning 610 job losses were confirmed pending a consultation process which will conclude today. This includes 360 from RAL and potentially 250 from Rex. The RAL business will be shut down, while Rex will continue but will be restructured. **We know how devastating this will be to those workers affected, and we're working to minimise the impact on hardworking families.**

NEXT STEPS

WORKING WITH ADMINISTRATORS

- We'll be working with administrators EY to **reduce job losses** and look at internal redeployment

CALLING FOR AN EQUITY STAKE

- We're calling on the Federal Government to take an **equity stake** in Rex and protect workers' entitlements

REDUNDANCY AND ENTITLEMENTS

- We're calling on a process for access to **redundancy and other entitlements** as quickly as possible for the affected workers

REDEPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES

- We are in talks about **redeployment opportunities** with Virgin and Dnata Ground for ground crew, catering, cabin crew and pilots and are in discussions about a process to fast track applications
