GET READY TO VOTE YES IN THE PAB

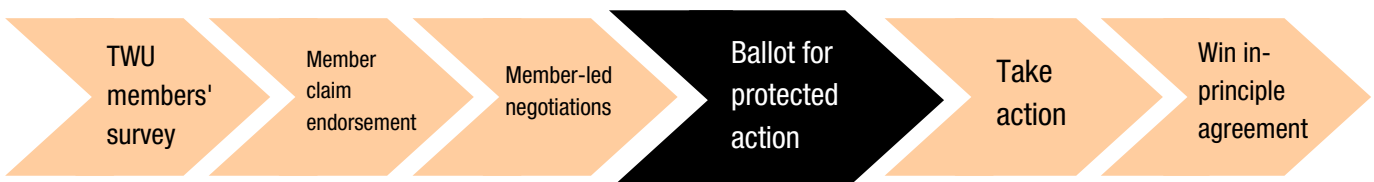
Once the PAB is approved, get ready to vote yes to all questions to show Dnata it must come back with a better offer.
