

DNATA MANAGEMENT BROUGHT BACK TO THE TABLE



Over Christmas it has become clear that the current Dnata deal still fell short of where the majority of TWU members would endorse the deal. At the same time we have been pushing Dnata to provide outstanding drafting in order to have a complete agreement for members to review.

Based on the above, it was agreed that your member led bargaining team would urgently come back together this week and discuss next steps.

In this meeting it was agreed that a revised position would be put to the company for:

- 6% + 6% pay increases – backdated
- Overtime for loaded rate employees increased to 40%
- Maintain nominal expiry date of 30 June 2026
- Increase in AM and PM shift penalty to 20%

The bargaining team met with the company on Wednesday 15 January and put forward the revised claim.

The company have been told to come back to the group by Friday 17 January with an improved position.

Delegates will be discussing escalation plans on site over coming days. If any of your contact details have been updated in recent weeks, please update with your organisers.
