# PRODUCTIVITY TRAINING UPDATE #1 YOU'RE ENTITLED TO A 1% PAY INCREASE



During the 2023-24 bargains in BevChain, TWU members fought hard to win an additional 1% pay through a **Productivity Training Increase.** This increase is to apply on or after the first pay increase due on 1 July 2025.

### **HOW DO I QUALIFY?**

To qualify, **TWU members must complete an online training course** through the TWU's website, which is provided to financial members free of charge.

After you successfully complete the training course, you will automatically qualify for the additional 1% increase in pay.

#### What if I'm not a TWU member?


Non-members would need to cover the cost of the training themselves or join the TWU as financial member to access it for free (if you join before 1st April).
