USING TWU-WON LAWS TO CALL ON BANKS TO PAY UP



Last year we called on the banks to step up to safeguard the cash-in-transit industry.

Though we had a win with a \$50 million lifeline for Armaguard, we knew there would need to be a **long-term plan** to protect your job security and your pay and conditions

USING LAWS WON BY TWU MEMBERS

- Last year, after two decades of campaigning, TWU members won laws that allow us to hold the economic clients at the top of the supply chain—like banks—to account
- We're now using these laws in an application that calls on the banks to pay up to ensure your job security, safety, and decent pay and conditions

STANDARDS WE'RE APPLYING FOR INCLUDE:

- · Essential PPE provisions
- Safe operating procedures
- Risk assessments
- Fair rates of pay and job security
- Critical vehicle standards

WHAT HAPPENS NOW?

- The application calls on the Fair Work Commission (FWC) to convene an industry conference, including the TWU, Armaguard, banks and retailers
- From there the FWC can set **minimum standards** for the whole supply chain, protecting your pay, conditions and job security and making sure the cash-in-transit industry can continue to be viable
- This is just the first step: we know there is significantly more work to be done on improving pay, conditions and safety, and will be part of our overall strategy to bring up CIT workers
