The message to StarTrack is clear: Come back to the bargaining table and resolve the outstanding issues.

The fight is still on to address the outstanding issues below:

- **2026 EA Expiry** (AUSPOST CEO PROMISED THIS IN 2021) So we can negotiate better pay and conditions sooner.
- **2** Fair Pay

StarTrack's current dodgy deal falls short of your claim over the next two years, with no wage increase (0%) in 2027.

3 15% Superannuation

To align with other major transport companies like TGE, Linfox and FedEx. StarTrack workers deserve a fair and dignified retirement – not broken promises.

- ▶ Stay tuned More information will follow as we meet with members and discuss the next steps if management do not move on the key outstanding items. Action is always the last resort, but these results have shown that members are serious about it.
